**STAMP FOR KATOVU SEED SECONDARY SCHOOL**


On the 04<sup>th</sup> of February 2025 I wrote to you asking for a written apology that was meant to be submitted within seven (07) working days but you didn't respond.

You are aware that I decided to open Katovu Seed School to respond to the pressure from my electorate that were in dire need of services of the same. In just two weeks we have an enrollment of 371 students and more are still coming.

I have been told that you went ahead and confiscated the stamp for the school from the interim school manager so that you can paralyze its operations without minding about the plight of new students and their poor families.

I wish to inform you that Lwengo District is governed through Article 180 and 183 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda by its duly elected leaders and NOT governed directly by the Resident District Commissioner since such can only happen after HE The President has invoked Article 202 of the Constitution (Takeover of a District Administration by the President) with two - thirds approval by Parliament.

**The purpose of this letter is to ASK you to surrender the stamp for Katovu Seed Secondary School to my office by close of business today 26th February 2025.**
